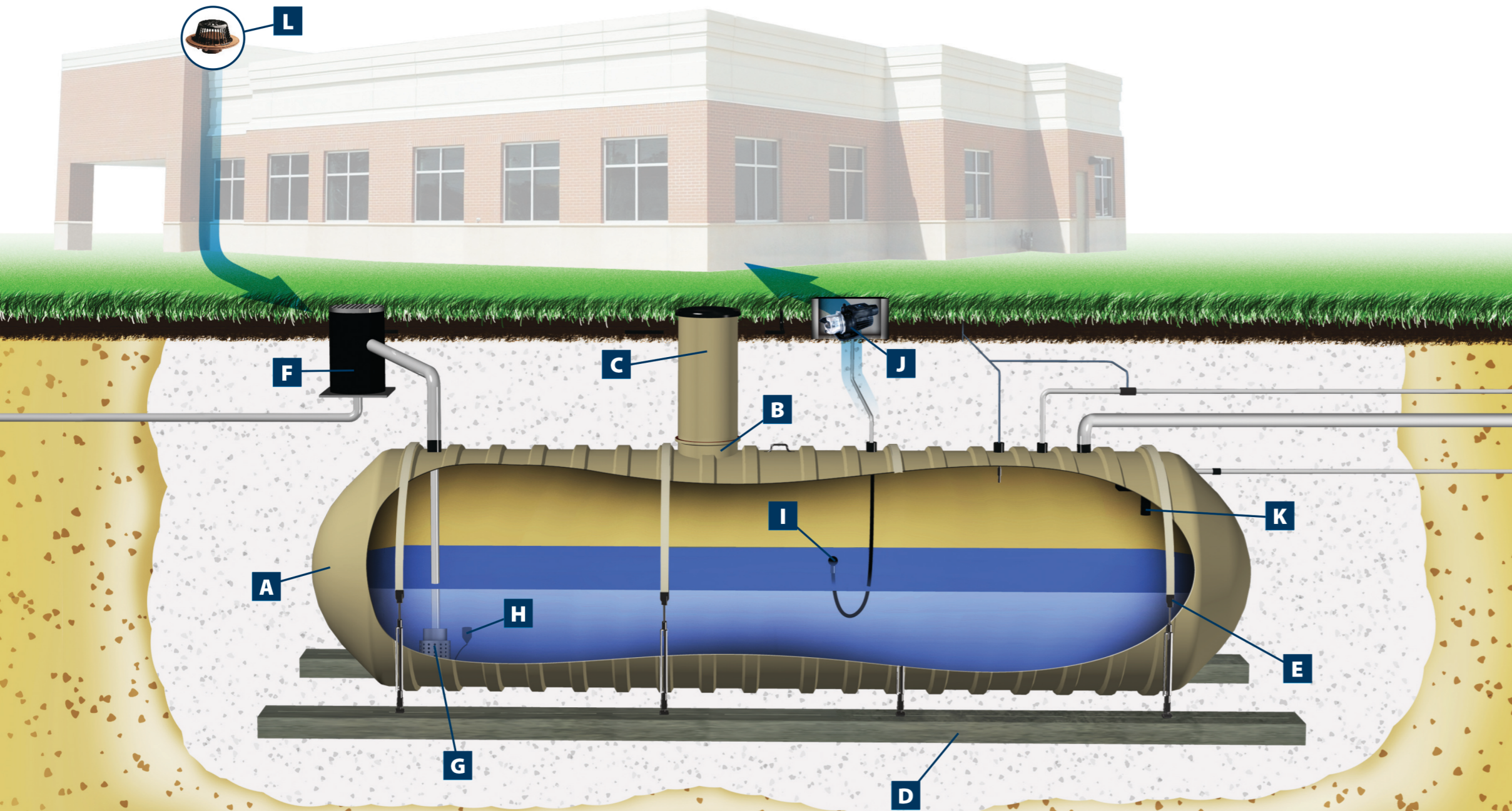


# RAINWATER HARVESTING SYSTEM
