FUNCTION

Leads, assists and performs the duties of the Fabricator. Assembles, repairs and finishes tanks. Insures tanks meet specifications as to dimensions and assembly standards. Responsible for the accomplishment of work performed by assigned personnel under the direction and authority of the supervisor.

DUTIES

1. Leads, assists and performs the duties of the Fabricator under the direction and authority of the supervisor.
2. Lays out tanks from shop drawings and certifies that the tanks meet those standards as to dimensions and assembly specifications.
3. Assembles tanks per instructions, written procedures, blueprints and drawings.
4. Inspects finished assembly per layout specifications and assembly standards.
5. Uses power tools to fabricate, prepare and install fittings.
6. Operates portable power tools, assembly jigs and handling equipment, etc., to repair tanks by grinding, patching, sanding, and hand lay-up.
7. Marks, stencils and labels tanks per blueprint and protects designed marks.
8. Rolls out bubbles during lay-up.
9. Procures & inventories materials, supplies, and resins used in assembly and repair.
10. Completes records and reports (including, but not limited to, work performed on each tank, etc.).
11. Operates material handling equipment as required.
12. Grinds and/or regrinds tanks/shells/parts.
13. Participates in the safety and good housekeeping programs as established within the plant.
14. Performs other related duties consistent with the nature of the job as directed by the supervisor.
